The Miracle of Christmas at Sight & Sound

On Saturday, Dec. 18, 2010, we will be going to see The Miracle of Christmas at the Millennium Theater in Lancaster, Pennsylvania. The cost is as follows: \$116.50 for those 19 years and older; \$92.50 for ages 13-18; and \$72.00 for ages 3-12. **These prices are based on a minimum of 40 persons on the motor coach. If there are less than 40 persons, the prices would increase and would depend on the number of persons going.** The cost includes: 1) round-trip transportation on a motor coach, 2) time at Kettle Kitchen, 3) Amish family-style dinner at the Good 'N Plenty Restaurant, tax and gratuity included, and 4) reserved seating for The Miracle of Christmas. **One-half of the cost must be paid at the rectory in order to reserve a place. The balance would be due by Sun., Oct. 31.**
