Pope Benedict XVI has established June 19, 2009 -

Jackals Game Trip



We are hoping to have a trip to see the New Jersey Jackals Minor League Baseball team. We are looking at Friday evening, July 24. The game will start at 7:05PM. If we have a group of 20 or more, we can get tickets for \$8.75 per ticket. They also have a group packaged for \$33.00 per person for a group of 40 or more. It would include the following: 1) picnic area, Reserved Seat and our own party host; 2) barbecue grill for approximately 90 minutes with burgers, hot dogs, chicken sandwiches, salad, chips and cookies; 3) unlimited domestic draft beer, soda and bottled water until the 7th inning; 4) coupon book for 10% discount at Strike Zone Merchandise; 5) group recognition during the game.
